

Project POTUS[™] 2022: How to use Judgify to submit your video

- 1. Go to <u>judgify.me/projectpotus</u>
- 2. Read the directions on the Judgify page and the official contest rules to make sure you've followed the project guidelines. Entries will be accepted starting Presidents' Day, February 21, 2022. When you're ready to enter, click 'submit entry' on the top righthand side of the webpage.
- 3. Enter information in the fields as directed, and attach your video file. If your video file is larger than 50mb, you'll have to reduce the size before you can submit your entry to Project POTUS. Google search to find a free file compressor, which will make your file smaller and make it possible to submit to Project POTUS. Ask your parent/guardian or teacher to help with this part!
- 4. Once you've entered, your video will be sent to the Presidential Jury, and considered for awards ranging from \$500-\$1500. Contest results will be published on <u>projectpotus.org</u> and on the <u>Benjamin Harrison Presidential Site YouTube page</u> in late May 2022, so make sure you check back to see the winners of the inaugural Project POTUS, 46 in 45 initiative.
